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OVERALL REPORT OF THE PROGRAMME:

BARASAT COLLEGE, Barasat, North 24-Parganas started its journey in a humble way in the year 1972 with the sole motto of socio-cultural and educational upliftment of the adjoining urban and rural areas of Barasat. Barasat College, a co-educational college, was initially affiliated by the University of Calcutta under the name 'Barasat Evening College' on 21st Nov 1972. Honours Course in Accounting and Finance was introduced in the session 1978-79 and honours in Marketing Course started in 2002-03. With the passage of time the need was felt to introduce Humanities stream and it was introduced in the day section in the session 1988-89 with B.A pass course - subjects offered were Bengali, English, Political Science, Philosophy, Education and History. Gradually Honours courses in Humanities were introduced. The Science stream with honours course in Geography and pass courses in Pure Science, Bio-Science and Computer Science have been introduced in 2003-04 and 2004-05 respectively. In the past our college was affiliated to Calcutta University. After the formation of West Bengal State University for the district of North 24-Parganas in 2008 our college has come under the affiliation of this new University. In the Session 2012-13 Honours in Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Zoology, Botany and Computer Science were added to our journey of education. From infinite number of Teaching & Non- Teaching Staff, Students, Local Administrators and Stakeholders, it has reached its present colossal status. It has outshined many academic institutions in spite of its humble infrastructure and goes on collecting accolades as usual, as days go by.

Ever since its inception, the college has been trying to achieve excellence and fulfil the objectives as envisaged in the NSS activities

The program started at 10:00AM with full enthusiasm of Volunteers, Teaching, Non-Teaching and Students of the College. It is noticed from the beginning that all of the participants are very excited for such long awaiting programme. The Participants were mainly the have-nots from the Subaltern groups and mainly consisted of orphans and children of slum-dwellers, who have no economic means to meet their basic needs. As their parents are unable to take proper care of them, due to their pecuniary conditions, often they have no alternative but to put their children under the care of NGOs so that at least these children do not have to starve to death.

The program initiated with a painting competition of the children and juvenile, both placed in separate Groups. As they did not have any copy, crayons, pencils and erasers for the same, all such items were provided to them by the College. The smile that lit up their faces were the greatest gifts that the College could receive.


The programs which followed subsequently were drawing, recitation and dancing Competitions. The Children were explained the basic dictum of all participations that- 'Participation is more important than winning.' Once they understood and absorbed it, the fear of defeat evaporated from their eyes and mind. Accordingly, they participated whole heartedly in the Competitions

.They have drawn many things from their own thinking which are really extraordinary and expressed their own imagination. It reflects their thoughts about the nature and the phenomenon of the society which they feel in our every day life. Some of them recited the poems nicely. They performed a dancing also. Lunch is distributed among them.

On the 2nd half of the day a awareness programme was held by Dr. Sanatan Bandhyopadhyay, a general physician and Nutritionist also delivered his speech very lucidly about the anemia, and general health awareness. Dr. Emphasis about lack of their personal hygiene of worm infection etc. It is found that socioeconomic factors like poverty and social neglect, diet and nutrition are mostly responsible for their health. Then prizes were distributed among the children.

Overall the programme was grand success.
