With the passage of time the need was felt to introduce Humanities stream and it was introduced in the day section in the session 1988-89 with B.A pass course - subjects offered were Bengali, English, Political Science, Philosophy, Education and History. Gradually Honours courses in Humanities were introduced. The Science stream with honours course in Geography and pass courses in Pure Science, Bio- Science and Computer Science have been introduced






